Volume to be removed is approximately 14.6 MBF/acre. **Areas 1** (84.0 acres), **3** (59.5 acres), and **4** (62.0 acres): Total 205.5 acres of regeneration harvest consisting of good quality 56-year-old Douglas-fir, western hemlock, and red alder, with a small component of Sitka spruce. Volume to be removed is approximately 32.6 MBF/acre. **Area 5** (in-sale R/W): There is approximately 261 MBF to be removed from 8 acres of in-sale R/W. **Area 6** (outside sale R/W): There is approximately 122 MBF to be removed from 4 acres of outside of sale R/W.

NORTHERN SPOTTED OWLS WERE NOT DETECTED IN SURVEY AREAS WITHIN OR ADJACENT TO THIS SALE. **SALE OBJECTIVES:**

This sale is aligned with the objectives of the NWO Forest Management Plan. The Plan presents guiding principles, a forest vision, and resource management goals.

Guiding Principles (in part) – To secure the greatest permanent value of these lands to the state, the State Forester shall maintain these lands as forest lands and actively manage them in a sound environmental manner to provide sustainable timber harvest and revenues to the state, counties, and local taxing districts. This management focus is not exclusive of other forest resources but must be pursued with a broader management context.

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PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. AS PART OF THAT PROGRAM, ODF SURVEYS ITS LANDS ON A CONTINUING BASIS FOR LAND MANAGEMENT, SPECIES PROTECTION, RESEARCH, AND OTHER REASONS. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT. THIS INCLUDES TIMBER SALES THAT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO BE UNSUITABLE HABITAT OR NOT DETRIMENTAL TO HABITAT. PLEASE REFER TO SECTIONS 30, 32, AND 33 OF YOUR CONTRACT PROSPECTUS, OR CONTACT OUR WILDLIFE INFORMATION COORDINATOR AT (503) 945-7374 FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2000 and 2001, using a protocol endorsed by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. There were no responses by northern spotted owls during any of these surveys. The sale is not affected by any currently known northern spotted owl activity centers.

This sale does not contain suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary.

Northern spotted owl survey results are considered valid until March 15, 2004. There are no seasonal operating restrictions associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.
