### TIMBER SALE SUMMARY JoJo

1. Type of Sale: clearcut, cash, sealed bid auction

2. Revenue Distribution: 100% BOF, Washington County

3. <u>Sale Acreage</u>: Area I is 71 acres and Area II is 48 acres determined by traverse.

4. Volume:

- 5. <u>Cruise Data</u>: The sale was variable plot cruised using a 40 BAF and full plots. The sale was cruised in March 2001. A top cruise diameter of 7 inches or 25% of DBH outside bark was used. Cruise statistics: CV 40.6% SE 5.3%.
- 6. <u>Timber Description</u>: The sale areas are well stocked stands of Douglas-fir. The age is 65 years old. The average DBH is 17 inches. Average volume per acre is 42.0 MBF Douglas-fir.
- 7. <u>Topography and Logging Method</u>: The sale is 80% tractor and 20% cable. Slopes range from 10% to 40%.

A ground based alternative to cable logging will be considered. A temporary stream crossing will be required. It must be built during the appropriate period for in stream work (July 1 to August 31). The area will be logged only in summer. Approximately 2 acres will require line pulling on 40% slopes. Maximum ground yarding distance is approximately 1500 feet.

**8.** Access: Access is via Hwy 47 to Johnson Road.

- 2. Cruise Method: The sale was variable plot cruised using a 40 BAF and full plots.
- 3. Sampling Intensity:

- **4. Form Factors:** Each tree was measured for form factor using a relaskop with a form point of 16 feet.
- **5. Height Standards:** Conifer and hardwood merchantable heights were estimated to the nearest foot.
- **6. Diameter Standards:** Diameters were measured outside bark at breast height to the nearest inch.
- 7. Grading System: All trees were graded favoring 40 foot segments.
- 8. **Merchantable Top:** Conifer and hardwood merchantable tops were measured to 7 inches and 9 inches, respectively, or 25% of DBH outside bark.
- **9. Computation Procedures:** Volumes were computed using the Super Ace 98 program.
- **10. Deductions:** Two percent of the conifer and the hardwood volume was subtracted from the computed volumes to account for hidden defect and breakage.
- **11. Cruisers:** The sale was cruised by Karen Tilley in March, 2001.
