PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. AS PART OF THAT PROGRAM, ODF SURVEYS ITS LANDS ON A CONTINUING BASIS FOR LAND MANAGEMENT, SPECIES PROTECTION, RESEARCH, AND OTHER REASONS. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT. THIS INCLUDES TIMBER SALES THAT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO BE UNSUITABLE HABITAT OR NOT DETRIMENTAL TO HABITAT. This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2000 and 2001, using a protocol endorsed by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. There were two nighttime observations of a northern spotted owl within 1.5 miles of the sale area. These responses were determined to be associated with a known northern spotted owl activity center greater than 1.5 miles from the sale area. There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles of the sale area.

This sale is generally unsuitable habitat for marbled murrelets. However, three trees with suitable nesting platforms were discovered within and adjacent to the sale area. These trees were climbed by a tree climber who is very experienced in the identification of murrelet nest cups. No evidence was found of past or present nesting by marbled murrelets.

Northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2004. There are no seasonal restrictions associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.
