THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES INFORMATION:

This STATE timber sale contract requires that PURCHASER comply with all laws, including the Endangered Species Act (ESA). This timber sale is within the Tillamook Burn. The Department of Forestry (ODF) policy does not require surveys for northern spotted owls in the Tillamook Burn due to the marginal quality of the habitat and the extensive amount of this habitat on the landscape. Because of the lack of suitable habitat, ODF has not surveyed the sale area shown in Exhibit "A" for marbled murrelets. ODF is engaged in an active threatened or endangered species survey process and does not guarantee that a threatened or endangered species will not be found as a result of those surveys or the surveys of others that might impact this sale. ODF may take steps, including contract alteration or termination as provided in section 32 of the contract, if ODF believes those steps are necessary to protect the interests of STATE. PURCHASER should take appropriate steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur.
