PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. AS PART OF THAT PROGRAM, ODF SURVEYS ITS LANDS ON A CONTINUING BASIS FOR LAND MANAGEMENT, SPECIES PROTECTION, RESEARCH, AND OTHER REASONS. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT. THIS INCLUDES TIMBER SALES THAT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO BE UNSUITABLE HABITAT OR NOT DETRIMENTAL TO HABITAT. This sale is located within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service.

This sale does not affect any northern spotted owl core areas established under the HCP. Due to its location in a demographic study area, surveys for spotted owls may occur in or near the sale area, during the life of the contract.

The sale area is approximately 30 to 39 years old, and is not considered potentially suitable marbled murrelet habitat under the HCP. Area IV of the sale is within 0.25 mile of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area established under ODF's Marbled Murrelet Management Plan for State Forests and protected under the HCP.

Seasonal operating restrictions apply to Area IV, from April 1 through September 15, annually. There are no other seasonal operating restrictions or felling deadlines associated with threatened and endangered species for this sale.
