Instead ODF will credit PURCHASER's timber account in the amount of \$348,755 after the project work is completed and accepted, as described in the section titled, "Credit for Project Work."

The timber sale areas contain negligible volumes of other logs to be paid for at the prices in Section 44.

PERFORMANCE SECURITY: 20% of bid value (unknown) **or** the total value of the project work (\$349,000), whichever is greater. Actual bond amount will be rounded up to an even \$1,000 unit.

THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES INFORMATION: This State timber sale contract requires that Purchaser comply with all laws, including the Endangered Species Act (ESA). This timber sale is within the Tillamook Burn. The Department of Forestry (ODF) policy does not require surveys for northern spotted owls in the Tillamook Burn due to the marginal quality of the habitat and the extensive amount of this habitat on the landscape. Because of the lack of suitable habitat, ODF has not surveyed the sale area shown in Exhibit "A" for marbled murrelets. ODF is engaged in an active threatened or endangered species survey process and does not guarantee that a threatened or endangered species will not be found as a result of those surveys or the surveys of others that might impact this sale. ODF may take steps, including contract alteration or termination as provided in Section 32 of the contract, if ODF believes those steps are necessary to protect the interests of state. Purchaser should take appropriate steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur.

Prospective purchasers are encouraged to contact the ODF wildlife information coordinator (503-945-7374) for further information or questions relative to threatened or endangered species surveys, future planned survey information, or other threatened or endangered species information.

SPECIAL REMARKS: **SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 39.**

Acres were determined by planimeter on an orthophoto.

Elevation is 2,000 to 2,600 feet.

80 hours of shovel time to block skid roads, pile firewood, site preparation and piling.

SALE OBJECTIVES: This sale is aligned with the objectives of the NWO Forest Management Plan. The Plan presents guiding principles, a forest vision, and resource management goals.

Guiding Principles (in part) – To secure the greatest permanent value of these lands to the state, the State Forester shall maintain these lands as forest lands and actively manage them in a sound environmental manner to provide sustainable timber harvest and revenues to the state, counties and local taxing districts. This management focus is not exclusive of other forest resources but must be pursued within a broader management context.

Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

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PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. AS PART OF THAT PROGRAM, ODF SURVEYS ITS LANDS ON A CONTINUING BASIS FOR LAND MANAGEMENT, SPECIES PROTECTION, RESEARCH, AND OTHER REASONS. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT. THIS INCLUDES TIMBER SALES THAT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO BE UNSUITABLE HABITAT OR NOT DETRIMENTAL TO HABITAT. PLEASE REFER TO SECTIONS 30, 32, AND 33 OF YOUR CONTRACT PROSPECTUS, OR CONTACT OUR WILDLIFE INFORMATION COORDINATOR AT (503) 945-7374 FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

This sale is located within the Tillamook Burn. Current ODF policy does not require surveys for northern spotted owls in the Tillamook Burn due to the marginal quality of the habitat and the extensive amount of this habitat on the landscape. Northern spotted owl surveys may occur within 3 miles of this sale, as part of ODF's survey of other planned management activities.

This sale does not contain suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary.

There are no seasonal restrictions associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.
