THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES INFORMATION:

This State timber sale contract requires that PURCHASER comply with all laws, including the Endangered Species Act (ESA). This sale is located within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan for northern spotted owls approved by U.S. Fish & Wildlife Service (USFWS). Because this sale is located within a northern spotted owl demographic study area, northern spotted owl surveys may continue throughout the duration of this contract. Because of the lack of suitable habitat, the Department of Forestry (ODF) has not surveyed the sale area shown in Exhibit "A" for marbled murrelets. However, ODF is engaged in an active threatened or endangered species survey process and does not guarantee that a threatened or endangered species will not be found as a result of those surveys or the surveys of others that might impact this sale. ODF may take steps, including contract alteration or termination as provided in Section 32 of the contract, if ODF believes those steps are necessary to protect the interests of State. Purchaser should take appropriate steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur.

Prospective purchasers are encouraged to contact the ODF Wildlife Information Coordinator (503-945-7374) for further information or questions relative to threatened or endangered species survey information.

SPECIAL REMARKS: SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 39.

The acreage for the timber sale was determined using orthophoto imagery on the ArcView GIS program.

Minor conifer species within the timber sale area are reserved from harvesting.

SALE OBJECTIVES: Reduce tree density to increase the vigor of overdense stands. Wildlife habitat will

be improved by thinning to allow for increased sunlight for understory development

and creating patches for landscape diversity.

Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. AS PART OF THAT PROGRAM, ODF SURVEYS ITS LANDS ON A CONTINUING BASIS FOR LAND MANAGEMENT, SPECIES PROTECTION, RESEARCH, AND OTHER REASONS. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT. THIS INCLUDES TIMBER SALES THAT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED TO BE UNSUITABLE HABITAT OR NOT DETRIMENTAL TO HABITAT. This sale is located within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) for northern spotted owls approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. This sale does not affect any northern spotted owl core areas established under the HCP. Due to its location in a demographic study area, surveys for spotted owls may occur in or near the sale area, during the life of the contract.

This sale is located in 30-35 year old timber and does not contain suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. Surveys for murrelets are not necessary. This sale is further than 0.25 miles from any Marbled Murrelet Management Areas established under ODF's Marbled Murrelet Management Plan for State Forests.

There are no seasonal restrictions associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.
