Because of the lack of suitable habitat, the Department of Forestry (ODF) has not surveyed the sale area shown in Exhibit "A" for northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets. However, ODF is engaged in an active threatened or endangered species survey process and does not guarantee that a threatened or endangered species will not be found as a result of those surveys or the surveys of others that might impact this sale. ODF may take steps, including contract alteration or termination as provided in Section 32 of the contract, if ODF believes those steps are necessary to protect the interests of State. 	Each tree on the timber sale area contains an aluminum nail and tag. The nails are partially driven into the tree bole at breast height. It will be the Purchaser's decision on whether to remove the nails from the "take" trees or not. However, in no case shall the nails be "bucked" out of the logs.
	Acres were determined by closed traverse.

Slash piling is required on 3 acres of phellinus patchcuts.

SALE OBJECTIVES: To thin an overstocked Douglas-fir progeny tree plantation and treat Phellinus root rot by patch cutting which will produce income and improve forest health while retaining selected trees for the progeny study.

PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT.
