ODF may take steps, including contract alteration or termination as provided in Section 32 of the contract, if ODF believes those steps are necessary to protect the interests of State. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS OF STATE TIMBER SALES NEED TO BE AWARE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF FORESTRY IS ENGAGED IN AN ACTIVE THREATENED AND ENDANGERED SPECIES SURVEY PROGRAM. AS PART OF THAT PROGRAM, ODF SURVEYS ITS LANDS ON A CONTINUING BASIS FOR LAND MANAGEMENT, SPECIES PROTECTION, RESEARCH, AND OTHER REASONS. PROSPECTIVE PURCHASERS ARE REMINDED THAT ODF SURVEYING EFFORTS MAY TAKE PLACE DURING THE LIFE OF ANY TIMBER SALE CONTRACT, AND THAT THE DISCOVERY OF A THREATENED OR ENDANGERED SPECIES IN THE VICINITY OF A TIMBER SALE MAY AFFECT OPERATIONS CONTEMPLATED UNDER THE CONTRACT. This sale was surveyed 6 times for northern spotted owls in 2002, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. There were no observations of spotted owls during any of these surveys. This sale is not affected by any known northern spotted owl activity centers.

This sale does not contain suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary.

Northern spotted owl surveys are valid until March 15, 2003. All timber must be felled by this date. There are no other seasonal restrictions associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.
