# **Biological Survey Report**

#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale is comprised of young alder and Douglas fir that is severely infected with Swiss Needle Cast disease. It does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets. There is suitable marbled murrelet habitat contiguous to the sale area.

## **Survey Results**

Northern spotted owl surveys were not required for this sale. However, northern spotted owl surveys for other planned management activities confirmed the presence of a spotted owl activity center within 1.5 miles of the sale area.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2001 and 2002, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. Murrelets were observed displaying behaviors indicating occupancy of the habitat contiguous to the sale area.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

This sale is within 1.5 miles of a northern spotted owl pair activity center. A Biological Assessment by Clint Smith concludes that harvest of the sale is in compliance with the "Agreement for the Conservation of Northern Spotted Owls<sup>2</sup>".

A Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA) has been established adjacent to the sale area. Harvest of the sale will not alter the MMMA.

#### **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal operating restrictions are in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, due to the adjacent MMMA. However, operations may be allowed from the period of two hours after sunrise until two hours before sunset, from August 6 through September 15.

## **Future Survey Plans**

There are no future survey plans for this sale. However, northern spotted owl and marbled murrelet surveys may take place around the sale area, due to the presence of the MMMA and as part of ODF survey of future planned operations.
