HARVEST TYPE: 276 acres in 7 areas of clearcut harvest of 43-year-old Douglas-fir with severe symptoms of Swiss needle cast, and 55 acres of partial cut in one area of 43-year-old Douglas-fir.

SALE LOCATION: Portions of Sections 20, 29, 30, 32, and 33, T2S, R7W, and Sections 4 and 5, T3S, R7W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: Approximately 25 miles east of Tillamook via Trask River County Road, South Fork Trask, Bales Creek, Miller, and Bushong Roads.

There is no project amortization. ODF will **not** reduce the price of a species to amortize the project work. Instead ODF will credit PURCHASER's timber account in the amount of \$288,632 after the project work is completed and accepted, as described in the section titled, "Credit for Project Work."

The timber sale areas contain negligible volumes of other logs to be paid for at the prices in Section 44.

PERFORMANCE SECURITY: 20% of bid value (unknown) **or** the total value of the project work (\$289,000), whichever is greater. Actual bond amount will be rounded up to an even \$1,000 unit.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

Acreages were determined using orthophotos and GIS.

The total price for hardwoods shall be paid prior to log hauling.

The full purchase price for hardwoods shall be paid on or before August 31, 2005.

All felling on Area 3, except for right-of-way timber cut in accordance with Project No. 1, shall not be allowed until October 1, 2003.

SALE OBJECTIVES: Harvest Douglas-fir, with severe symptoms of Swiss needle cast, and alder to prepare for planting with other native conifer species.

The information shown on the Exhibit "A" map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

Habitat Suitability

This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Northern spotted owl and marbled murrelet surveys are not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is not within 1.5 miles of any known northern spotted owl activity centers or within 0.25 miles of any Marbled Murrelet Management Areas.

Operational Considerations

There are no seasonal restrictions or felling deadlines associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.

Future Survey Plans

There are no future survey plans for this sale. However, surveys for northern spotted owls will be conducted in and around this sale as part of a monitoring study for spotted owls in the Tillamook Burn.
