Habitat Suitability

Several units of this sale contain, or are contiguous to, potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

The units involved in this sale were originally surveyed as two separate sales: North Fawcett and Simmons Creek.

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2001 and 2002, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. There were no observations of northern spotted owls during any of these surveys. An unknown *Strix* sp. owl was heard during one survey in 2001. Although it was felt that this was not likely to be a spotted owl, additional follow-up visits were conducted, with no further observations.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2001 and 2002, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Murrelets were heard at North Fawcett, Site 1 in 2001, but 10 additional surveys in 2002 yielded no further detections. Murrelets behaviors indicating occupancy were observed at Simmons Creek, Site 1 in 2001, adjacent to one of the sale units. As a result, an existing Marbled Murrelet Management Area was expanded to include this habitat.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers affecting this sale.

Portions of this sale are within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions are in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, for portions of this sale within 0.25 miles of the Marbled Murrelet Management Area. However, operations may be allowed from the period of two hours after sunrise until two hours before sunset, from August 6 through September 15.

Northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2005. By ODF policy, marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 2007. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2005.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale.
