### **Habitat Suitability**

Areas 1, 2 and 4 of this sale contain potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. Area 1 contains potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

### Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2001 and 2002, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1</sup>. There were no observations of northern spotted owls during any of these surveys. Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2001 and 2002, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>2</sup>. There were no observations of marbled murrelets during any of these surveys.

### Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

### **Operational Considerations**

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2005. After completion of an additional year of surveys in 2003, survey results will be valid until March 15, 2006. Felling, except for felling associated with project work, will not be

allowed prior to the completion of northern spotted owl surveys in 2003. After completion of the 2003 northern spotted owl surveys, all timber should be felled by March 15, 2006.

By ODF policy, marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 2008.

### Future Survey Plans

ODF will conduct an additional year of northern spotted owl surveys for this sale area in 2003. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
