Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

Habitat Suitability

This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is not within 0.25 miles of any Marbled Murrelet Management Areas.

Operational Considerations

There are no seasonal restrictions or felling deadlines associated with northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets for this sale.

Future Survey Plans

There are no future survey plans for this sale. ODF will be conducting a spotted owl survey across the entire Elliott State Forest in 2003, however. A portion of these surveys will take place in or around the sale area.
