#### **Habitat Conservation Plan Area**

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

## **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

#### **Survey Results**

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2001 and 2002, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. Marbled murrelets were not observed during any survey visits.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

Area 3 and a portion of Area 4 of this sale are within 0.25 miles of Marbled Murrelet Management Areas.

#### **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect for Area 3 and that portion of Area 4 within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area from April 1 through September 15, annually. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually. By ODF policy, marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2008, within the contract duration of this sale.

#### **Future Survey Plans**

There are no future survey plans for this sale. ODF will be conducting a spotted owl survey across the entire Elliott State Forest in 2003, however. A portion of these surveys will take place in or around the sale area.
