Instead ODF will credit PURCHASER's timber account in the amount of \$53,373.79 after the project work is completed and accepted, as described in the section titled, "Credit for Project Work."

The timber sale areas contain negligible volumes of other logs to be paid for at the prices in Section 44.

HARVEST METHOD: Tractor yarding. A mechanical feller-buncher with a lateral reaching beam is required for all mechanical felling. All oversized timber shall be hand felled.

PROJECTS: 13,010 feet of road brushing and 200 feet of road construction; 8.5 miles of road improvement, and 7 road closure points at the completion of the sale. Approximately 30 acres of dozer piling, and approximately 413 acres of fir stump treatment with Sporax fungicide. Fell, skid, and pile submerchantable material.

FEES: None.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

SPECIAL REMARKS: **SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 39.**  
Acres were determined using GIS data.

- (1) Any ponderosa pine or sugar pine having a gross scaling diameter of less than 8 inches shall be pencil bucked for the purpose of determining the volume of the log.
- (2) All other conifers having a gross scaling diameter of less than 6 inches shall be pencil bucked for the purpose of determining the volume of the log.

SALE OBJECTIVES: To create a healthy, insect and disease resistant stand by reducing stocking levels in all size and age classes and by favoring ponderosa pine as a residual species.

The information shown on the Exhibit "A" map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

## **Biological Survey Report**

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### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest, near the edge of the range of the northern spotted owl.

### **Survey Results**

The Sun Pass State Forest was surveyed for northern spotted owls from 1992 – 1994 and again in 1999 and 2000 using standards that met or exceeded protocols endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1</sup>. These surveys were done as monitoring surveys under ODF's Eastern Oregon Long-Range Management Plan. There were no responses to any surveys in 1999 and 2000. Periodic owl surveys will begin again in March of 2005.

There are no known bald eagle nests affecting this sale.

The nest of a non-listed species, the northern goshawk, was found during a northern goshawk survey of the Sun Pass State Forest in 2003. A core area has been established around this nest site.

### **Known T&E Resources**

This sale is not affected by any known northern spotted owl activity centers or bald eagle sites.

### **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal operating restrictions will apply annually from April 1 through June 15 to allow for goshawk surveys. In the event that nesting goshawks are found within or adjacent to the sale area during a particular year, seasonal operating restrictions will be extended through August 31 of that year, for the area within .25 mile of the nest site.

There are no other seasonal restrictions associated with threatened, endangered or sensitive species for this sale.

### **Future Survey Plans**

Surveys for northern goshawks will continue across the Sun Pass State Forest in 2004, and will be conducted annually in the vicinity of the goshawk nest. Northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted during the life of the contract, beginning in March 2005.
