Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. There were 2 observations of a northern spotted owl in 2002. Additional visits in 2002 and 2003 resulted in no further observations of northern spotted owls, and the responses from 2002 were attributed to a non-territorial single (or "floater") owl.

This sale was surveyed for marbled murrelets, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Site 1 was surveyed in 2000, 2001 and 2002. Site 2 was surveyed in 2001 and 2002. There were no detections of marbled murrelets during any of these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2006. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2006.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale after 2003. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
