# Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

# Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

# Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. The sale area was surveyed as two sites. Site 1 was surveyed in 2000, 2001 and 2002. There was 1 detection of a marbled murrelet in 2000 and 2 detections in 2002 at Site 1. However, behaviors indicating murrelet occupancy were not observed. Site 2 was surveyed in 2001, 2001, 2002, and again in 2003, in conjunction with the continuing survey of an adjacent timber sale. There were no observations of murrelets at Site 2.

## Known T&E Resources

Portions of this sale are within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA).

# **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal restrictions will apply from April 1 through September 15, annually, for those portions of the sale that are within 0.25 miles of the MMMA. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

Marbled murrelet survey results for Site 1 are valid until April 1, 2008, and surveys for Site 2 are valid until April 1, 2009. All timber should be felled prior to April 1, 2008.

There are no future survey plans for this sale.
