Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. The sale does not contain potential habitat for marbled murrelets; however, there is potential habitat adjacent to the sale area.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2002 and 2003, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. There have been several responses from northern spotted owls within 1.5 miles of this sale. However, these responses were associated with known activity centers greater than 1.5 miles from the sale area. The sale will be surveyed again in 2004.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2002 and 2003, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². The survey area included 3 sites. No murrelets were detected in the potential habitat adjacent to the sale area (site 3). However, murrelets were detected on several occasions at sites 1 and 2, and subcanopy behaviors were observed at site 2 in 2002. The unit associated with sites 1 and 2 is no longer included in this timber sale. The Powderhouse sale area is further than 0.25 miles from these survey sites.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will apply from March 15 through August 31, 2004, or until northern spotted owl surveys are complete, indicating no resident northern spotted owls within 1.5 miles of this sale. This restriction excludes road-related project work.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2006. Once the 2004 northern spotted owl survey is complete, survey results will be valid until March 15, 2007. Marbled murrelet surveys are valid until April 1, 2009. All timber should be felled prior to March 15, 2007.

Future Survey Plans

This sale will be surveyed again for northern spotted owls in 2004. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract, as part of surveys for other planned timber sales and monitoring of owl activity centers.
