## Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

## Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

## Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2002 and 2003, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. It was surveyed as 2 separate survey areas, each with one site. Marbled murrelets were observed during one survey visit at Area 1 in 2002. Subsequent surveys in 2002 and 2003 resulted in no further observations, and no evidence of murrelet occupancy was observed.

## Known T&E Resources

A portion of Area 2 of this sale is within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA).

## **Operational Considerations**

There are no seasonal operating restrictions associated with marbled murrelets for this sale. Less than 1 acre of the sale is within 0.25 miles of a MMMA, and there is a substantial ridge separating the sale area from the MMMA, so operational noise disturbance would not be an issue.
