ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT:

The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

Prospective purchasers are encouraged to contact the Astoria ODF District at 503-325-5451 for further information or questions relative to threatened or endangered species surveys, future planned survey information, or other threatened or endangered species information.

SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 39.

Within the "Seasonal Restriction Boundary" shown on Exhibit A, between April 1 and September 15, annually: (1) No use of chainsaws; (2) No use of large machinery; (3) No use of explosives; and/or (4) No helicopters flying at a low level. These operations may occur during the period of August 6 and September 15, based upon a biological evaluation by STATE of the breeding activity in the area. Daily timing restrictions may also be used to minimize disturbance. Such permission shall be approved in writing by STATE. Between September 16 and March 31, there are no hourly restrictions on these activities.

Acreage for the sale areas was determined by GIS.

All felling must be completed by March 15, 2006.

Project work in the Hug Point area is required to be completed by September 30, 2004.

SALE OBJECTIVES:

This timber sale is aligned with the objectives of the NW Oregon Forest Management Plan. The Plan presents guiding principles, a forest vision, and resource management goals. This sale has specific objectives of advancing several of the sale areas toward more complex structures; increasing wood growth on residual trees; and for Areas 1, 2, 4, 6, 9, 10, and 11, converting these stands to healthy forest plantations which will also serve as wildlife forage areas for about a decade.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. Portions of the sale contain potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2002 and 2003, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. There were no observations of northern spotted owls during any of these surveys.

Area 2, 5, 7, 8, 10 and 11 of this sale were surveyed for marbled murrelets in 2002 and 2003, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group^{2,3}. There were no detections of marbled murrelets during any of these surveys.

Area 8 (AST 57, Sites 2 and 3) of this sale has been surveyed at varying levels of intensity since 1994. In 1995 and 1996, murrelets were observed displaying subcanopy behaviors in Area 8. From 1997 thorough 2000, some monitoring surveys were done, but did not fully cover the area. From 2001 through 2003, the area was divided into 2 sites (i.e. site 3 was added), with 12 surveys per year at each

site. There have been no detections of marbled murrelets during any surveys since 1996.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles of this sale.

The Simmons Ridge Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA) was established in response to subcanopy detections in 1995 and 1996. Area 8 is within this MMMA. ODF has completed a Biological Assessment that describes the potential short and long term effects of the harvest activities on the MMMA. ODF has discussed the proposed activity with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS), and USFWS and ODFW reviewed a draft of the Biological Assessment. The long term goal of the prescription is to accelerate the development of marbled murrelet habitat within the MMMA, while minimizing potential short-term risks.

Operational Considerations

Operations will be restricted to the period of September 16 to March 31, annually, for those portions of the sale that are within 0.25 miles of the MMMA. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2006. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2006.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale after 2003. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
