Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. There were no observations of northern spotted owls during any of these surveys.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². The survey area included 5 survey sites. Four of these sites had no detections of murrelets. Murrelets were observed on one occasion at Site 1 in 2003, but behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed. The sale area associated with this survey site was removed from the final sale configuration.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2007. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010. All timber should be felled prior to March 15, 2007.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no future survey plans for this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program. Northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles, and marbled murrelet surveys within 0.25 miles, of this sale during the life of the contract, as part of surveys for other planned timber sales.
