Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. A female northern spotted owl was heard within 1.5 miles of the sale area during surveys in 2003. In 2004, additional responses greater than 1.5 miles from the sale resulted in the establishment of a northern spotted owl activity center. The activity center is greater than 1.5 miles from the sale.

This sale was surveyed for marbled murrelets in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². There were no detections of marbled murrelets during any of these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2007. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2007.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale after 2003. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
