#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. The sale does not contain and is not adjacent to potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

#### Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1</sup>. A northern spotted owl was observed on one occasion in 2003. Additional visits in 2003 and 2004 resulted in no further observations of northern spotted owls, and the response from 2003 was determined to be a non-territorial single (or "floater") owl. The sale will be surveyed again in 2005.

#### Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

#### **Operational Considerations**

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2005 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2007. After the 2005 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2008. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2008.
