Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010. All timber should be felled prior to April 1, 2010.
