## **Habitat Suitability**

This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest, near the edge of the range of the northern spotted owl.

## **Survey Results**

The Sun Pass State Forest was surveyed for northern spotted owls from 1992 – 1994 and again in 1999 and 2000 using standards that met or exceeded protocols approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. These surveys were done as monitoring surveys under ODF's Eastern Oregon Long-Range Management Plan. There were no responses to any surveys in 1999 and 2000. Monitoring surveys are again taking place in 2005 and 2006.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

This sale is not affected by any known northern spotted owl activity centers or bald eagle sites.

## **Operational Considerations**

There are no other seasonal restrictions associated with threatened, endangered or sensitive species for this sale.

## **Future Survey Plans**

Northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted on Sun Pass State Forest in 2005 and 2006.
