Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. On one occasion in 2004 a northern spotted owl was observed during these surveys. Additional visits in 2004 resulted in no further observations of northern spotted owls, and the response from 2004 was determined to be a non-territorial single (or "floater") owl. This sale is being surveyed again in 2005.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². There were several observations of marbled murrelets during these surveys, including one subcanopy observation at Pickett Loop site 3, indicating occupancy. Because this site is considered to be occupied, it was not surveyed again in 2004.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles of this sale.

As a result of a subcanopy behavior observed during surveys a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA) was established within 0.25 miles of this sale. In addition, another MMMA is also located within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2005 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2007. After the 2005 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2008. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2008. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010.

Future Survey Plans

ODF will survey this sale for northern spotted owls in 2005 to extend the duration of the contract. Additionally, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
