The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State. including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

## **SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 2455.**

- Net and gross acreage was determined by using GPS, digital orthophotos, and GIS.
- Areas IV and V have seasonal operating restrictions for harvesting and project work due to their close proximity to Marbled Murrelet Management Areas.

Access roads for these sale areas will be surfaced, which will allow operations to continue during the wet season.

- Area IV contains a patch cut and a reserve area.
- Stream temperature monitoring instruments are located in the Yaquina River just outside the east boundary of Area V. These data recording devices must be protected during harvesting activities in Area V.

SALE OBJECTIVES:

The objective of this timber sale is to reduce stand densities, enhance tree growth, and establish a layering component in accordance with the District's Implementation Plan.

## **Habitat Suitability**

This sale does not contain suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale does contain potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

## **Survey Results**

Surveys for northern spotted owls are not necessary for this sale.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. A marbled murrelet presence detection was recorded during a survey in 2004. Additional surveys in 2004 yielded no further detections of murrelets and behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed for this sale.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles of this sale. Portions of the sale are within 330 feet of Marbled Murrelet Management Areas.

#### **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually for those portions of the sale within 330 feet of nesting habitat within Marbled Murrelet Management Areas. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15,

annually. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010. All timber should be felled by April 1, 2010.

# **Future Survey Plans**

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
