#### **Habitat Conservation Plan Area**

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

## Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. Areas 1 and 2 were surveyed in 2003 and 2004 with no observations of murrelets. Murrelets were detected as present in Area 3 in 2004, and murrelets were detected as present in Area 4 on one occasion in 2003 and on two occasions in 2004. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed.

#### **Known T&E Resources**

Area 4 of this sale is located within 330 feet of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area. All other areas of the sale are further than 330 feet from any Marbled Murrelet Management Areas.

### **Operational Considerations**

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, for those portions of Area 4 that are within 330 feet of the MMMA. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually following consultation with the area biologist.

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010. All timber should be felled by April 1, 2010.

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale.
