Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2003 and 2004 using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. A female northern spotted owl was observed within 1.5 miles of the sale area once in 2003 and once in 2004. As a result of these responses and other responses greater than 1.5 miles from the sale boundary, a resident single activity center was created. The new activity center is greater than 1.5 miles from the Lone Star sale.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2004, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2007. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2007. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2010.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Marbled murrelet surveys are not scheduled to be conducted within 0.25 miles of the sale at this time.
