HARVEST TYPE: **Areas 1 and 2:** 169 acres of "automark" partial cut of approximately 70-year-old hemlock, Douglas-fir, and other conifers. Volume to be removed in Areas 1 and 2 is approximately 26 MBF/acre.

**Area 3:** 50 acres of "automark" partial cut of approximately 65-year-old hemlock, Douglas-fir, and other conifers. Volume to be removed in Area 3 is approximately 25 MBF/acre.

**Area 4 (In-Sale R/W):** There are 5 acres of new road construction R/W consisting of hemlock, Douglas-fir, other conifers, and hardwoods. Volume to be removed in Area 4 is approximately 57 MBF/acre.

SALE LOCATION: Sale areas are located in portions of Sections 10, 15, 16, and 18, T6N, R7W, and Section 13, T6N, R8W, W.M., Clatsop County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: All Areas can be accessed from Astoria or Jewell via Highway 202. Turn north onto West Tidewater Road near Milepost 22. Area 1 is about a tenth of a mile up West Tidewater Road on the left side. Areas 2 and 3 can be accessed from Tidewater Mainline near Milepost 22 and the TW Spur 130 Road. **A key is required to access Areas 2 and 3, and can be checked out from the Astoria District Office.**

There is no project amortization. ODF will **not** reduce the price of a species to amortize the project work. Instead ODF will credit PURCHASER's timber account in the amount of \$79,544 after the project work is completed and accepted, as described in Section 2630, "Credit for Project Work."

The timber sale areas contain negligible volumes of other logs to be paid for at the prices in Section 1740.

FEES: \$5,218 to Weyerhaeuser Company for an access easement shall be paid to Weyerhaeuser prior to log hauling from Area 3 for the first 1.2 MMBF hauled over the Tidewater 130 Spur Road. An additional fee of \$4.35/MBF shall be paid for volume exceeding 1.2 MMBF hauled from Area 3 (see Section 2120).

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

**SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 2455.**

Timber sale acreage was determined by mapping sale areas on an ortho photograph and using ArcView to calculate acres.

**Project work must be completed prior to October 31, 2007.**

**All felling must be completed by March 15, 2008.**

**A key is required to access Areas 2 and 3, and can be checked out from the Astoria District Office. Purchaser will be required to check out keys from Weyerhaeuser Company prior to commencing operations.**

**SALE OBJECTIVES:**

This sale is aligned with the objectives of the NWO Forest Management Plan. The Plan presents guiding principles, a forest vision, and resource management goals.

Guiding Principles (in part) – To secure the greatest permanent value of these lands to the state, the State Forester shall maintain these lands as forest lands and actively manage them in a sound environmental manner to provide sustainable timber harvest and revenues to the state, counties, and local taxing districts. This management focus is not exclusive of other forest resources but must be pursued within a broader management context.

### Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

### Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2004 and 2005, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1</sup>. There was one observation of a female northern spotted owl in 2004. Additional visits in 2004 and 2005 resulted in no further observations of northern spotted owls, and the response from 2004 was determined to be a non-territorial single (or "floater") owl.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2004 and 2005, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>2</sup>. Murrelets were detected as present in 2005 on one occasion. However, behaviors indicating murrelet occupancy were not observed. In addition, surveys for marbled murrelets have been conducted in Areas 1 and 2 at various times since 1992. Murrelet presence, and behaviors indicating occupancy have been observed in these sale areas.

## Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles of this sale.

Areas 1 and 2 of this sale are located within a Marbled Murrelet Management Area. Portions of Area 3 are located within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area. A preliminary Biological Assessment of the potential impact of this sale on marbled murrelets has been conducted. This assessment concludes that the Rip Tide timber sale as currently planned poses a moderate risk to viability of the West Tidewater MMMA.

## Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually for Areas 1 and 2 and for those portions of Area 3 within 330 feet of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2008. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2011. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2008.

## Future Survey Plans

ODF will be conducting ongoing marbled murrelet surveys in the Rip Tide sale and adjacent areas. Spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
