HARVEST TYPE: **Area 1:** Approximately 21 net acres of wind-throw salvage. Volume to be removed is approximately 14 MBF/acre.  
**Areas 2 and 3:** There also is approximately 45.5 net acres of wind-throw salvage, removing approximately 5 MBF/acre.

SALE LOCATION: Timber Sale Areas are located in portions of Section 30, T7N, R7W, and Section 36, T7N, R8W, W.M., Clatsop County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: Timber Sale Areas can be accessed via the California Barrel Road off of Highway 202, approximately 17 miles east of Astoria. Follow this main road for approximately 2¼ miles and then turn right and travel approximately ½ mile to Area 1. Follow the California Barrel Road to Spur 30 and turn left. Travel approximately 1¼ mile and turn right, go approximately ¼ mile and turn right again. Area 3 is approximately ¼ mile. To reach Area 2, travel up the California Barrel Road to the 3½ mile marker and turn left. Travel for approximately ½ mile.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

SPECIAL REMARKS: **SEASONAL RESTRICTIONS APPLY - SEE SECTION 2455.**  
Timber sale acreages were determined by using aerial photos and GIS.

SALE OBJECTIVES: This sale is aligned with the objectives of the NWO Forest Management Plan. The Plan presents guiding principles, a forest vision, and resource management goals.

Guiding Principles (in part) – To secure the greatest permanent value of these lands to the state, the State Forester shall maintain these lands as forest lands and actively manage them in a sound environmental manner to provide sustainable timber harvest and revenues to the state, counties, and local taxing districts. This management focus is not exclusive of other forest resources but must be pursued within a broader management context.

Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

## Biological Survey Report

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### Habitat Suitability

This sale does not contain suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale contains potential habitat for marbled murrelets in Area 1 only.

### Survey Results

Following consultation with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, tree climbing was used in lieu of protocol murrelet surveys for Area 1 of this sale. The climbing surveys on April 18, 2006 reported no sign of murrelet use. Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for Areas 2 and 3.

Surveys are not necessary for northern spotted owls. However, the salvage area was covered by surveys for northern spotted owls in 2004 and 2005 as part of surveys for an adjacent timber sale, and northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

### Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

### Operational Considerations

There are no seasonal operating restrictions associated with threatened or endangered species for this sale.
