# Survey Resulta

Surveys for northern spotted owls are not necessary for this sale.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2005 and 2006, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group<sup>1</sup>. Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.
