Habitat Suitability

This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest, near the edge of the range of the northern spotted owl.

Survey Results

The Sun Pass State Forest was surveyed for northern spotted owls from 1992 -1994, 1999 - 2000, and 2005 - 2006 using standards that meet or exceed protocols approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. These surveys are done as monitoring surveys under ODF's Eastern Oregon Long-Range Management Plan. There were no responses to any surveys in 1999, 2000, 2005 and 2006.

Known T&E Resources

There are no known northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.2 miles of this sale. There are no known bald eagle nest sites within 0.5 miles of this sale. There are bald eagle nests in vicinity of the currently planned haul route.

Operational Considerations

If nesting occurs within 0.25 miles or 0.5 miles line of sight, seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from January 1 to August 1, unless hauling is rerouted away from the nest. There are no other seasonal restrictions associated with threatened, endangered or sensitive species for this sale.

Future Survey Plans

There are no future survey plans for this sale.
