Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

A survey waiver has been issued for unsurveyed potential marbled murrelet habitat north of the timber sale boundary. For suitable habitat in the remainder of the sale area, surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually for sale areas within 330 feet of potential marbled murrelet habitat north of the sale as per the survey waiver.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2011. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2014. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2011.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale.
