HARVEST TYPE: Area 1 is a 109-acre moderate partial cut; Area 2 is 19 acres of group selection; Area 3 is a 132-acre moderate partial cut; Area 4 is a 109-acre modified clearcut; and Area 5 is a 41-acre modified clearcut. Area 6 R/W is 4 acres of the timber sale area. Timber is a mix of 35- to 60-year-old Douglas-fir, Noble fir, and western hemlock.

SALE LOCATION: Portions of Sections 25 and 26, T1N, R6W, W.M., Washington County, Oregon, and portions of Sections 23 and 27, T1N, R6W, W.M., Tillamook County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: 25 miles from Forest Grove office to timber sale area. Highway 6 to milepost 33 then left on Beaver Dam Road. At milepost 8.5, south on Saddle Mtn. Road, 0.5 mile up to the timber sale area.

There is no project amortization. ODF will **not** reduce the price of a species to amortize the project work. Instead ODF will credit PURCHASER's timber account in the amount of \$275,210 after the project work is completed and accepted, as described in Section 2630, "Credit for Project Work."

The timber sale areas contain negligible volumes of other logs to be paid for at the prices in Section 1740.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

Top 300 trees in Areas 4 and 5, stream buffers, and green tree retention areas.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potential habitat for marbled murrelets. Sale areas 1 - 4 and a portion of Area 5 are located within the historic Tillamook Burn. By ODF policy northern spotted owl surveys are not required within the Burn. The portion of sale area 5 outside of the historic Tillamook Burn boundary does not contain suitable habitat for northern spotted owls.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2006 and 2007, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Surveys for northern spotted owls are not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers within 1.5 miles or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2013. All timber should be felled by April 1, 2013.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted for other operations and as part of an investigation into the presence or absence of spotted owls in the Tillamook Burn within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Marbled murrelet surveys are not scheduled to be conducted within 0.25 miles of the sale at this time.
