Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2006 and 2007, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys. Surveys will be conducted again in 2008.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2006 and 2007, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

The sale is within 1.5 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center. A Biological Assessment of the sale's impact on the activity center has been conducted, and it concludes that the sale is expected to have a low risk of negatively affecting the occupancy and productivity of the northern spotted owl site. The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service reviewed a preliminary version of this assessment and concurred that this sale is not likely to result in incidental take of spotted owls.

There are no marbled murrelet management areas within 0.25 miles of this sale.

Operational Considerations

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2008 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no new resident spotted owls.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2010. After the 2008 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2011.

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2013.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2011.

Future Survey Plans

ODF plans to conduct spotted owl surveys in 2008 to extend the duration of the sale contract. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
