This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest, near the edge of the range of the northern spotted owl.

## **Survey Results**

The Sun Pass State Forest was surveyed for northern spotted owls from 1992 -1994, 1999 - 2000, and 2005 - 2006 using standards that meet or exceed protocols approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. This sale is within 1.2 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center. A biological assessment of the sale's impact on this owl site has been conducted. It concludes that the Hammerhead sale poses a low risk of negatively affecting the occupancy and productivity of the Sand Ridge spotted owl pair.

There are no known bald eagle nest sites within 0.5 miles of this sale. There are bald eagle nests in vicinity of the currently planned haul route.

#### **Operational Considerations**

If bald eagle nesting occurs within 0.25 miles or 0.5 miles line of sight, hauling should be restricted during the nesting season (January 1 through August 1) or rerouted away from the nest. There are no other seasonal restrictions associated with threatened, endangered or sensitive species for this sale.
