#### **Habitat Suitability**

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls. This sale does not contain potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

### **Survey Results**

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2006 and 2007, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service<sup>1</sup>. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.
