HARVEST TYPE: Regeneration harvest containing approximately 66 acres of 46-year-old third-growth Douglas-fir/hemlock/hardwood mix.

SALE LOCATION: The timber sale is located in portions of Section 3, T23S, R10W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: From Coos Bay, travel north on Highway 101 to Reedsport and proceed east on Highway 38 for approximately 13 miles to the Loon Lake Road junction. From here, proceed for approximately 6 miles to the 7700 Road junction. Once on the 7700 Road, proceed for another 2 miles to the timber sale area.

Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. Acreage was determined by electronic digitizing using 2005 digital orthophotography and ArcMap GIS software program. Existing interior road acreage was deducted.

Sections 1010, "Definitions of Terms"; 1740, "Log Prices"; 2015, "Log Accountability"; 2020, "Log Measurement"; 2030, "Log Branding and Painting"; and Exhibit C, contain special language for pulp and biomass removal. PURCHASER is not contractually obligated to remove pulp or biomass debris from the timber sale area and will not be held liable by STATE if said material is not removed.

The sale area is designated to be logged during the dry season. PURCHASER must comply with the "Winter and Wet Weather Option" if operations are conducted during the wet season (Section 2610).

The information shown on the Exhibit A map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.
