HARVEST TYPE: The timber sale is 79 acres of a moderately stocked single age stand that is predominantly second-growth Douglas-fir. It is composed of approximately 107-year-old Douglas-fir of good to average quality with a minor component of red alder, redcedar, Sitka spruce, and bigleaf maple. Conifers range from 86 to 210 feet tall while hardwoods are about 65 feet.

SALE LOCATION: The timber sale area is located in portions of Sections 20 and 29, T22S, R10W, W.M., Douglas County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: From Coos Bay, proceed north on Highway 101 to Reedsport, turn east on Highway 38 and proceed to Loon Lake County Road (County Road 3). Travel approximately 1.5 miles and turn right on 7500 Road. Take the 7500 Road to the 7000 Road and turn right. Travel approximately 2 miles to project point A (Junction of the 7000 and 7140).

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Restrictions on operations due to T&E species considerations are included in the prospectus. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2005 and 2006, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were detected as present at 3 of 4 sites during both years of survey. However, behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed. A stationary detection was reported during surveys in 2005 and presence detections were reported both years. An additional year of surveys was conducted at this site in 2007. Following three years of surveys without a visual sub-canopy observation, this site was determined to not be occupied by marbled murrelets.

Known T&E Resources

A portion of this sale is within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMA).

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions for the use of explosives will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually. This includes the use of explosives associated with rock quarries in or within 1.0 miles of likely nesting habitat within a MMMA, and the use of explosives associated with road construction in or within 0.25 miles of likely nesting habitat within a MMMA.

Marbled murrelet survey results for Areas 1, 3 and 4 are valid until April 1, 2012. All timber in these areas should be felled by April 1, 2012. Marbled murrelet survey results for Area 2 are valid until April 1, 2013.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale.
