HARVEST TYPE: The timber sale is 69 acres of a moderately stocked single age stand that is

predominantly second-growth Douglas-fir. It is composed of approximately 115-yearold Douglas-fir of good quality with a minor component of red alder and western hemlock. Conifers range from 80 to 198 feet tall (average height is 125 feet) while

hardwoods are about 76 feet in height.

Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were detected as present at Site 1 during a single survey visit in 2007. Murrelets were detected as present at Site 2 during a single survey visit in 2008. However, behaviors indicating murrelet occupancy were not observed.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is within 0.25 miles of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually for sale areas within 330 feet of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually.

In addition, seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, for the use of explosives associated with rock quarries in or within 1.0 miles of potential marbled murrelet habitat, and for the use of explosives associated with road construction in or within 0.25 miles of potential marbled murrelet habitat.

Current marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2014. All timber should be felled by April 1, 2014.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale at this time.
