Habitat Suitability

This sale contains suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and potential habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2006 and 2007, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is within 1.5 miles of a northern spotted owl activity center. A Biological Assessment of the sale's impact on the activity center has been conducted. It concludes that the Wakefield timber sale poses a moderate risk to continued persistence and productivity of the spotted owl site.

Haul routes associated with this sale are within ¼ mile of multiple Marbled Murrelet Management Areas (MMMA). Seasonal restrictions will apply on these haul routes.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually for hauling within 330 feet of a MMMA. Operations may be allowed from 2 hours after sunrise until 2 hours before sunset from August 6 through September 15, annually. Landing and road construction or improvement involving blasting, drilling and shooting, shall not be allowed from April 1 through September 15 within 0.25 miles of a MMMA. The use of explosives associated with rock quarries shall not be allowed from April 1 through September 15 within 1 mile of a MMMA.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2011. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2013. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2011.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
