HARVEST TYPE: The sale is two modified clear cut areas totaling 194 acres. Sale areas are predominately 55-year-old red alder with scattered Douglas-fir.

SALE LOCATION: Portions of Section 36, T4N, R8W, and Section 31, T4N, R7W; W.M., Clatsop County; and Sections 1 and 12, T3N, R8W, and Section 6, T3N, R7W; W.M., Tillamook County; Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: Highway 26 to the 101 Road to the 108 Road to Cronin Ridge Road. The sale is approximately 12 miles from the highway. There are two gates along the haul route; both have ODF locks. Keys may be obtained from the ODF office in Forest Grove.

As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.



Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys. Surveys are being continued in 2009.

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2006 and 2007, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group². Murrelets were not detected during these surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2009 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2011. After the 2009 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2012. Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2013. All timber should be felled by March 15, 2012.

Future Survey Plans

ODF is conducting spotted owl surveys in 2009 to extend the duration of the sale contract. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract. Also, ODF will be conducting surveys for marbled murrelets within 0.25 miles of the sale during the life of the contract.


