Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for northern spotted owls.

Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2007 and 2008, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys. Surveys will continue in 2009.

Surveys for marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

No felling, except for felling associated with project work, shall be allowed prior to the completion of the 2009 northern spotted owl surveys indicating no resident spotted owls.

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2011. After the 2009 surveys are completed, the survey results will be valid until March 15, 2012.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2012.

Future Survey Plans

ODF plans to conduct spotted owl surveys in 2009 to extend the duration of the sale contract. In addition, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
