- (7) The STATE representative will be designated when your plan is approved and is the person who will inspect and issue instructions regarding performance.
- (8) Show names of subcontractors to be used for any or all phases of the operations. If subcontractors are not known, or are changed later, give notification to the STATE representative prior to commencement of work by subcontractor.
  - Show projected dates for commencement of both projects and logging. If projected dates need to be changed at a later date, notification must be given to the STATE representative by supplemental plan or otherwise, prior to commencement of such operations.
- (10) The STATE representative will furnish extra copies of Exhibit A of the contract for your use in preparing the operations map. The map shall use the following legend and show:
  - 1. Landing locations, approximate setting boundaries, and probable sequence of logging the settings. Number the settings in sequence.
  - 2. Locations of spur roads planned for construction, other than those required by the timber sale contract. Provide spur road specifications.
  - 3. Location of proposed tractor yarding roads. Show if and how marked on the ground.
  - 4. Location of temporary stream crossings.
  - 5. List the sequence of performing project work.
  - 6. Location of rock sources attach pit development plans.





- (5) Minimum Scaling Specifications. Review Section 2040 or 2045, "Log Removal," of the Contract. Species, or combined species can be separate entries. Information serves as a basis for scaling (see also Items (16) thru (18)), and is required to show existence on the sale. SUM (lump sum material). SUB (submerchantable material). SUB, as used by the State, references that material containing at least 10 bf (net) but less than the lower merchantable net volume limit or grade requirements for other merchantable (Per MBF) entries. Per MBF, SUM, and SUB must be indicated by checking the appropriate column. Species with the same specifications and value are combined into one entry. <u>CLEARING</u>. This work shall consist of clearing, removing, and disposing of all trees, snags, down timber, brush, surface objects, and protruding obstructions within the clearing limits.

Where clearing limits have not been marked, the clearing limits shall extend 4 feet back of the top of the cutslope and 4 feet out from the toe of the fill slope, or as directed by STATE. Clearing debris shall not be placed or permitted to remain in or under road embankment sections. Clearing debris shall not be left lodged against standing trees.

GRUBBING. This work shall consist of the removal or digging out of stumps and protruding objects.

All stumps shall be completely removed within the limits of required grubbing. Grubbing debris shall not be placed

or permitted to remain in or under any road embankment sections. Grubbing debris shall not be lodged against standing trees.

All blue marked trees along the 21, 25, and 32 Roads shall be cut and the stumps grubbed. PURCHASER shall exercise care not to disturb roots of adjacent leave trees.

<u>CLEARING AND GRUBBING DISPOSAL.</u> Scatter through openings in the timber outside of the cleared right-of-Way.

<u>SIDECAST RETRIEVAL</u>. Previous sidecast soil on the 21, 25, and 32 roads shall be retrieved and blended into the existing road surface.

<u>DRAINAGE DITCHES</u>. Ditches shall be "V" shaped, approximately 2 feet wide, with a depth of approximately 1 foot below the subgrade.

Suitable material removed from the drainage ditch shall be blended into the existing road suface.

LEAD OFF DITCHES. Construct and /or improve leadoff ditches at points W and X.

BLADE AND SHAPE EXISTING SURFACE. The existing road surface, including shoulders and turnouts, shall be Bladed and shaped to produce a surface which is uniform, consistent to grade, and crowned at ½ inch per foot of width.

Outslope surface where a ditch is not applicable, as directed by STATE.

PURCHASER shall apply water during blading and shaping of the 21, 25, and 32 Roads. PURCHASER shall apply Water for reconstruction of remaining roads when sufficient moisture is not present to prevent segregation.


