Survey Results

This sale was surveyed for northern spotted owls in 2008 and 2009, using a protocol endorsed by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service¹. Northern spotted owls were not observed during these surveys.

Intensive surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2003 and 2005, using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group (PSG)². Murrelets were not detected during these surveys. Because these surveys were not conducted in consecutive years they do not meet PSG protocol or ODF policy parameters. In lieu of protocol surveys the suitable habitat trees in the sale were climbed and searched for evidence of marbled murrelet nests in February, 2010. No evidence of marbled murrelet nesting was found during the tree climbing surveys.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Operational Considerations

Current northern spotted owl survey results are valid until March 15, 2012. Marbled murrelet tree climbing survey results are valid until April 1, 2014.

All timber should be felled by March 15, 2012.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF has an active survey program and northern spotted owl surveys will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
