As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alterations, suspensions or termination.

Habitat Suitability

This sale does not contain potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets. This sale is located within the historic Tillamook burn. By ODF policy northern spotted owl surveys are not required.

Survey Results

Surveys for northern spotted owls and marbled murrelets are not necessary for this sale.

Operational Considerations

There are no seasonal restrictions for marbled murrelets or spotted owls for this sale.

Known T&E Resources

There are no northern spotted owl activity centers or Marbled Murrelet Management Areas affecting this sale.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for survey of this sale. However, ODF will be conducting spotted owl surveys in and around this sale, as part of an investigation into the presence or absence of spotted owl use of the Tillamook Burn. In addition, owl surveys for other planned operations will be conducted within 3 miles of this sale during the life of the contract.
