This sale is located in the Sun Pass State Forest, near the edge of the range of the northern spotted owl.

Survey Results

The Sun Pass State Forest was surveyed for northern spotted owls from 1992 -1994, 1999 - 2000, and 2005 - 2006 using standards approved by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. These surveys are done as monitoring surveys under ODF's Eastern Oregon Long-Range Management Plan. There were no responses to any surveys in 1999, 2000, 2005 and 2006.

Known T&E Resources

This sale is not affected by any known northern spotted owl activity centers or bald eagle sites.

Operational Considerations

There are no seasonal restrictions associated with threatened, endangered or sensitive species for this sale.

Seasonal hauling restrictions will be in effect from May 1 through June 30 of each year in order to avoid impacts to calving elk.

Future Survey Plans

Northern spotted owl monitoring surveys may be conducted during the life of the contract. In addition, ODF may conduct northern goshawk surveys in the vicinity of the sale during the life of the contract.
