HARVEST TYPE: Regeneration harvest of two units containing approximately 54 acres of predominately 102- to 145-year-old mature second growth Douglas-fir saw-timber and a small component of Red alder and Western hemlock.

SALE LOCATION: The timber sale area is located in portions of Section 23, T23S, R11W, W.M., Coos County, Oregon.

DIRECTIONS TO TIMBER SALE AREA: From Coos Bay, take Coos River Highway to the 1000 Road (Marlow Creek). Proceed 10.5 miles up the 1000 to the 9000 (Elk Creek). Proceed 3.7 miles up the 9000 to the 9300 Road and head 2.3 miles up the 9300 Road to the 9360 Road. Drive down the 9630 Road by vehicle to point C. Continue on foot into Area 1 or 2.

ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT COMPLIANCE STATEMENT: The Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) is engaged in an active threatened and endangered (T&E) species survey program. Surveys, determinations, and management measures are developed and implemented in good faith compliance with federal and state Endangered Species Act (ESA) requirements. Purchasers are required to comply with all federal and state laws, including the Endangered Species Act. Purchaser should take steps to be certain that no ESA violations occur. Prospective purchasers of timber sales are reminded that ODF surveying efforts may take place any time during the term of a timber sale contract. As part of the survey program, ODF surveys its lands on a continuing basis for land management, species protection, research, and other reasons. During the contract term, T&E survey work and/or the discovery of a threatened or endangered species within or in the vicinity of a timber sale may affect operations contemplated under the contract. In the event a threatened or endangered species is found within or near this sale, ODF may take steps necessary to protect the interests of the State, including contract alteration, suspension, or termination.

Acreage was determined by electronic digitizing using 2005 digital orthophotography, 2008 Lidar and ArcMap 9.3 GIS software program.

Spotted Owl density surveys of the Elliott State Forest will be conducted during 2011 (Section 1520).

Hauling south on the 1000 Road and south on the 9000 Road is not allowed from October 15 through May 15 (Section 2130).

Create 108 snags by topping and girdling at various tree heights (Section 2335).

All logging equipment used in Ground-Based logging operations shall be cleaned to prevent the spread of invasive and noxious weeds (Section 2416).

The sale area is designed to be logged during the dry season. Purchaser must comply with Winter and Wet Weather option if operations are conducted in the wet season (Section 2610).

Road layouts and logging plans must give priority to scattered green tree retention pods and protection of stream buffers. Logging plans must be approved by STATE before work can begin.

SALE OBJECTIVES:

The objectives of this timber sale are to provide revenue for the Common School Fund and to create a young-age class stand in accordance with balanced landscape approach to the Elliott State Forest Management Plan.

The information shown on the Exhibit "A" map(s) are approximate locations. Exact locations of features represented by map symbols shall be determined on site and shall depend upon the conditions that exist on site. Activities shall be conducted based upon features determined on site rather than features shown on maps.

Habitat Conservation Plan Area

This sale is within an area covered by a Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) approved by the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Incidental Take Permit (ITP) for the HCP covers northern spotted owls. Under the provisions of this HCP, surveys are not required for northern spotted owls.

Habitat Suitability

This sale contains potentially suitable habitat for marbled murrelets.

Survey Results

Surveys for marbled murrelets were conducted in 2007 - 2010 using a protocol developed by the Pacific Seabird Group¹. Murrelets were detected as present at sites 1 and 2 during surveys in 2007. During surveys in site 1 in 2008, there were several observations of marbled murrelets including subcanopy observations indicating occupancy. Murrelets were detected as present in site 2 during surveys in 2008, however behaviors indicating occupancy were not observed. The survey sites

were reconfigured as sites 3 and 4 for surveys in 2009 and 2010. Murrelets were detected as present in both sites during 2009. Murrelets were detected as present in site 3 in 2010 with no observations recorded in site 4. There were no subcanopy behaviors indicating occupancy during surveys in sites 3 and 4.

Known T&E Resources

As a result of subcanopy behaviors observed during surveys to site 1 in 2008, a portion of the timber sale was removed and a Marbled Murrelet Management Area (MMMA) was established adjacent to the reconfigured timber sale areas 1 and 2. In addition, sale area 1 is adjacent to a preexisting MMMA.

This sale is within 1 mile of a northern spotted owl pair activity center.

Operational Considerations

Seasonal operating restrictions will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, for sale areas 1 and 2 within 300 feet of a Marbled Murrelet Management Area. Operations may be allowed from no earlier than two hours after sunrise until no later than two hours before sunset from August 6th through September 15th, annually.

Seasonal operating restrictions for the use of explosives will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, for the use of explosives associated with rock quarries in or within 1.0 miles of potential marbled murrelet habitat, and for the use of explosives associated with road construction in or within 0.25 miles of potential marbled murrelet habitat.

Seasonal operating restrictions for the use of large aircraft (including Type 1 helicopters) will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, in or within 0.25 miles of potential marbled murrelet habitat. Seasonal operating restrictions for the use of small aircraft (including single engine airplanes and Type II and III helicopters) will be in effect from April 1 through September 15, annually, in or within 360 feet of potential marbled murrelet habitat. For all aircraft, overflights must be greater than 500 above nesting habitat.

Seasonal operating restrictions for the use of explosives will be in effect from March 1 through July 7 (or until it has been determined that northern spotted owl pairs are non-nesting or the nest has failed) within 1.0 mile of a nest tree or activity center.

Marbled murrelet survey results are valid until April 1, 2016.

All timber should be felled by April 1, 2016.

Future Survey Plans

ODF has no plans for further survey of this sale. However, ODF may conduct operational, density, and/or activity center monitoring surveys for northern spotted owls within 3 miles of this sale during the duration of the contract.
